Preliminaries - These are works indirectly related to a building element, but which is essential for the contractor to carry out its obligations under the contract.

Work element – These are works directly related to a building element.

Respondents shall include a value for each dollar sign, that is, for:

- 1) Each individual element of work - "Subtotal"
- 2) Each group element - "Total"
- 3) The combined sheet total.

Note: A balance carried down, on one page, is to be carried forward to the next page.
