- Q1 Who supplies and installs the solid surfacing window sills? General Contractor to supply see Q2 for contact.
- Q2 Who supplies and installs the cabinetry and counter tops? General Contractor to supply& install. Cabinetry refer to A8

Q3 - Who supplies all the doors and frames?

General Contractor to supply/ with approved Millwork Shop House Drawings.

- Q4 Who supplies all the door hardware? General Contractor to supply Refer to sheet A9.
- Q5 Who supplies baseboard? General Contractor/ Millwork Shop House.
- Q6 Drawing A9 noted all hardware to be supplied by 8+ hardware- please provide further information- standard hardware or specialized?

The Hardware is specialized. All doors and frames shall be prepped by Millwork Shop House ready to receive door hardware. Door hardware schedule shall be issued to the awarded contractor only.

- Q7 -Where is the location of storage? Any other items to be saved and stored for use later on? Existing furniture & workstation cubes to be removed from site and taken to the dump.
- Q8 Removal of AC fan coils etc. is this to be removed and disposed by AC Contractor and if so, does the AC contractor work directly for Government?

All AC fan coils removal shall be done by Air Care, NIC to General Contractor. Wall repair is within the GC scope of works.

- Q9 Removal of Fire Alarm Systems is done by Fire Alarm contractor or do we remove?

 All Fire Alarm Devices shall be removed by Fire Alarm contractor & is NIC to General Contractor.
- Q10 Do we allow for the Fire Alarm Systems contractor costs or is to be directly for Government? Fire Alarm Systems work shall be a direct contract with Government.
- Q11 Do we allow for paint works to stairwells? Do we paint walls only? Or railing system as well? Yes, walls only as noted. Railing and hand rail work is NIC to General Contractor.
- Q12 What is WD1? What is the species of wood and finishing?

 Refer to sheet A6. WDI Walnut solids and veneers, quarter cut bookmatch complete with custom stain 30%.
- Q13 Is a painted reveal for all doors?

 Yes, except where hollow metal frame is noted.
- Q14 May we have the spec on Resilient flooring? Refer to sheet A5 see RF1 & RF2.
- Q15 Is structural work required?

- Q16 Please advise if Resilient flooring and tile work is to be by client direct contractor.

 Tile shall be supplied by the owner. General Contractor to install

 Resilient flooring; General Contractor to supply & install. Specifications as noted refer to sheet A5.
- Q17 Can we carry floor leveling as a lump sum allowance value? Do you want to advise this allowance value we should all carry?
 - Patch and repair any large missing pieces of concrete are within General Contractor scope.
- Q18 The existing ceiling grid is in good condition (same as ceiling tiles). Do you want to consider leaving the grid in place and/or reuse any ceiling tiles and/or reuse any of the existing light fixtures?

 Ceiling and grid tiles to be replaced as noted. Existing light fixture to be removed as noted.

 For Clarity Rooms 321 & 322 have both existing new light fixtures and ceilings. The GC is to reconfigure lighting as indicated.
- Q19 Should we consider all smoke detectors and signaling devices to be "New" and not existing? And if the devices are existing which ones?

 Smoke detectors Horn / Strobe Pull stations devices will be by Government General Contractor.

 Exist signs are in the General Contractors scope.
- Q20 Regarding the data, what size conduits should we allow for? Are we to allow for a conduit run back to the IT closet or should we allow for a "stub up" into the ceiling and run plenum rated cable either in cable trays or free wired? Provide stub up into the ceiling allow for 3". Access control / security conduit use 3/4", receptacles ½" conduit communications 1" typical.
 - Cabling will be completed by Government Contractor.
- Q21 Can a specification be provided for the floor receptacles and are there any power requirements available for the modular furniture?
 - Carry an allowance of \$5,000.00 in bid
- Q22 On the recent addendum regarding hallway 304- should we consider the fixtures shown as "new" and not existing? The two 2x2 light fixtures indicated in corridor 304 shall be new.
